- a. Questions 1-12 associated with Solicitation COIL-22-C-0001 are addressed below:
- 1. Would the government consider the solicitation as a small business set aside to encourage opportunities for small businesses and their participation?
 - The Government encourages small business participation but can not set aside this opportunity for small business.
- 2. Is there any incumbent contractor performing services currently? If yes, we request the government to share the details?
 - There is no incumbent contractor performing these services.
- 3. Can the government provide details about the current website stack in addition to Drupal 7? Website is hosted on a LAMP stack configuration.
- 4. Who will provide the translation?

 If the question is referring to Page 20, Paragraph 7.1.4.4.c, COIL will provide the translated documents during contract performance.
- 5. Under Instructions, the price section must also be submitted as a Microsoft Excel document. Do we assume the government will provide an Excel template for this response?

 The Government will provide a template attached to this amendment, which outlines the requested data in Figure 2 on Solicitation page 24 and Figure 3 on Solicitation page 25. The templates only provide format of information and not data specific to labor categories, hours or price. Each offeror is responsible for providing all pricing information for each CLIN specific to the offer.
- 6. It is our understanding that, within eight months, the vendor is expected to complete Website Design and Development within the base year, and the subsequent three months will be for support.
 - The Government's goal is to complete Website Design and Development within 8 months. The solicitation does not define the base period of performance as a "year". Appreciate the question, as a review of the performance period shows Clause 52.217-9 should be corrected to read in Paragraph (c) "3 years and eight months" vice "3 years and six months". Corrected page 12 of the solicitation is attached.
- 7. Is the cover letter included in the 30-page limit requirement?

 If a cover letter is provided, it will not be included in the technical proposal 30 page limit.
- 8. How many past performances are required to be submitted? Is Past Performance counted against the 30-page limit?
 - There is no required number of past performance reference(s) defined in the solicitation. Yes, past performance proposal pages are included in the proposal page limit of 30 pages.
- 9. Is the <u>coil.gov</u> domain already procured Yes, the domain name is already secured.
- 10. We request the government to clarify the scope of the Online forms. Do we consider automation of the grant application form in the PDF https://www.openworld.gov/grants/apply-grant
 - Forms posted on the website must function properly, e.g. viewable and can be downloaded.
- 11. The Past Performance section requests a "narrative rating assigned by the Government requiring agency or official commercial source", is the government asking for a CPARS rating and if so, do they want just the rating or would they like copies of the CPARS to be included in the document as well?

The overall past performance rating (CPARS or non-Government rating system) assigned to the representative contract; with individual assessed category ratings (e.g. quality of product/service, schedule, customer satisfaction, key personnel retention etc) should be included in the proposal. The actual ratings document should not be included in the past performance proposal submission but the rating received for contract performance (e.g. exceptional, marginal, unsatisfactory etc) should be provided in the proposal submission. Of course, the entity responsible for the rating, with an <u>accessible</u> point of contact with telephone number, that can verify the assigned rating shall be provided.

- 13. The solicitation states that the Government requires CLIN 0001 delivery in 6 months after the contract award on page 15. But on page 16 it mentions that COIL's goal to support this effort is 8 months or less from the time of award to Phase 7 Asset Delivery. We request the government clarify this information about CLIN durations to help us prepare the schedule, level of effort, and associated costs.

Please see answer to question 6 above.

- b. Pages 12, 15, 23 and 24 of Solicitation COIL-22-R-0001 are corrected and replaced with this amendment.
- c. Solicitation COIL-22-R-0001 remains unchanged, with the exception of the items addressed above.

Statement of Work

Scope and Objective

1. This contract is established to provide professional and technical services in support of design, development and content management for the OpenWorld.gov website (to be renamed to COIL.gov) in Drupal Version 9 using the contractor's infrastructure for development and testing. COIL shall provide a copy of the existing website for use in this upgrade. This support will provide, but is not limited to design, development and test of an operational public facing website using Drupal 8/9,

- (1) The technical section shall address the intended project plan which will be used in the design and development of the website. The project plan must address each phase of the website build identified in the SOW and how each phase will be accomplished. Also the proposal shall address how each website performance characteristic shall be accomplished as well as potential ways to appeal to website target audiences. Any product (software, hardware etc) purchased for incorporation or use for website operation shall be identified; specifying the product name, version and purpose of use with this system. Also a delivery schedule detailing the completion of each CLIN and website Phase listed in the statement of work shall be included in the proposal. This delivery schedule, as negotiated, will be the basis for the performance schedule contained in Section F of the resulting contract. If a license is required for a product the license must be provided with the proposal.
- (2) A well-qualified staff is critical to the success of the website build. The proposal shall document the make-up and qualifications of the proposed staff. A staffing plan and management plan shall also include list of job categories, descriptions and minimum qualifications for all proposed staff.
- (3) Key Personnel shall be identified and their project roles, responsibilities, and authority shall be described. The Offeror shall submit an employee resume, limited to three (3) pages, for each individual to be assigned to perform the work required under this acquisition. Include all relevant training and certifications. Each resume shall be followed by a succinct description of the individual's relevant experience. The Offeror shall specify for each of the individuals identified, the approximate percentage of their total time that they will be available for this effort. Resumes of any subcontractors proposed by the Offeror shall be so identified and shall also be limited to three (3) pages. A consolidated list of hours detailing the proposed hours for each individual by CLIN shall also be provided (in PDF and Microsoft Excel) and shall correspond with the performance schedule(s) for each CLIN. (4) Past Performance Section – Proposals (including any proposed Subcontractors) shall comply with the instructions, as follows:
